Everything was sold with prices ranging from £440 for heifer calves to £2,150 for best milkers.

Top priced heifer was judged to be the Champion and first prize heifer by Mr Kelly Hill who had a terrific class of eight heifers to choose from.

The top priced heifer at £2,150 came from Mr G.J. Sutton, Astbury whose three heifers averaged £1,983.
