All Sold To A Top Of £2,100

With another large entry of over seventy milkers, trade was much better than expected with another full ring of buyers for all types and prices.

There was a total clearance with twenty-two selling over £1,700 of which ten were over £1,800, five over £1,900 and one over £2,000.

Trade is definitely back reflecting the lower calf prices.

Top price was £2,100 for a calved heifer from The Glanmarton Herd of The Whitticase Family of St Martins. Their entry of four heifers averaged £1,935.

Top priced cow was £1,930 for a second calver from S.M. Gilman & Partner, Lilleshall.

The average for the whole dairy entry was actually only back £12 on the week at £1,597 considering thirty more milkers were sold.

This reflects the consistency of the Drayton milk trade with something to suit everyone and also bearing in mind that nearly two hundred dairies had been sold in three days when added to Monday's milking herd dispersal.

Breeding bulls sold to £1,290 for a twenty-month-old Hereford. Heifer calves sold to £200.
