In-calf heifers from WJ Lewis & Co, Farndon, sold to £1,520 and yearlings to £700.

Twelve cattle in all sold for over £2,000 including the Boyah herd dispersal.

A top price of £2,350 was achieved at the dispersal sale of Richard Sisson's Boyah herd of Holstein Friesians which had been moved from their home at Haughton, Stafford, to Market Drayton Market to be sold.

The leading lady was the fortnight calved 2nd calver sired by Aintree Linchpin which had recorded 8,740kgs as a heifer and was giving 34kgs when sold.

Five others sold for over £2,000 with £2,150 being paid for another 2nd calver. 3rd calvers sold at £2,050 and £2,000 and a calved heifer at £2,050.

Served heifers sold to £1,400 twice, yearling heifers to £750 and heifer calves to £620.
