TOP PRICES - HEIFERS £2,420 - COWS £2,380

After the recent hot days, the air temperature had finally cooled but the trade in the ring certainly had not!!

66 milkers passed through the dairy ring today and although it was a good show of cattle, they were not quite the standard of last week's entry. The good heifers and cows would have been £150 head dearer this week - on a like for like basis from last week.

Topping the sale was a British Friesian heifer from a regular vendor she sold giving 30kgs at 12 days calved and reached $\pm 2,420$, another British Friesian from the same home at $\pm 2,350$ and Holstein $\pm 2,200$.

Non-milk producer D. & W. Davenport, Brereton sold their heifer at £2,300. Mr K.J. Morris, Beoley £2,270, £2,110 and £2,010, Wyndford Wagyu, Chadwell £2,150, Mrs V.E. Lloyd, Buerton £2,100, O.C. Whittaker & Sons, Tabley £2,050.

Milky cows were highly sought after once again with a regular vendor selling a second calver to £2,380.

Mr R.N. Thompson, Sudbury second calved cows giving 38kgs to £2,100 and another to £,2000. PA. & JA. Adams, Newcastle-Under-Lyme continued their dispersal and their third calved cow made £2,010.

A special consignment of 34 spring calving cows from Friend Farms Ltd, Oakley sold to a very consistent trade. Peaking at £1,380 twice and generally selling between £1,100 to £1,380.

A nice two year old Hereford stock bull from Betley Court Partnership, Betley sold to £2,000.
