£2,500 TOP PRICE

No shortage of buyers but the quality was again very mixed with first quality in short supply. Again there was something for everyone and someone for everything. Hopefully, next week's Show and Sale will attract a better calibre entry.

The best sold well to a top of £2,500 for a calved heifer from Richard Thompson, Sudbury. John and Ebs Whittaker sold their heifers at £2,450 and £2,000. Other heifers sold to £2,100 and £1,980.

Cows were again a very strong trade with third calvers to £2,320 from W J Oakes & Partners, Lach Dennis, and £2,280 from P A & J A Adams, Newcastle-under-Lyme. Fifth calvers sold to £1,720 and sixth calvers to £1,600. Dry cows sold to £1,680.

A large entry of dairy followers met very keen interest despite the lack of grass with in-calf heifers selling to £1,720, bulling heifers to £900, yearlings to £710 and heifer calves to £205.

Stock bulls sold to £3,000 (Limousin 41 months), Charolais £1,650 (15 months) and £1,550 (16 months).
