With the grass growing and more confidence in the dairy sector this brought a better quality of heifer to the ring today. This in turn brought a larger number of buyers back to ringside.

First through the ring today were the calves and those topped at £400 from Knaptoft Hall Farming, Lutterworth with others from the same home at £350 and £340. L.E. Weston & Sons, Terrick sold to £380 and £360.

Returning to the Drayton Youngstock sale were annual sellers J. Greenwood & Partners, Westbury-On-Severn. Their consignment of thirty-one heifers calved mainly Aug-October reached £2,280 for a De Su Appeal daughter and others to £2,220, £2,050, £2,000.

Less bulling heifers forward this month, these were a little too strong for bulling and made £830 to £850.

Yearlings again as with previous months saw the best trade and largest numbers forward. DA. & PR. Waring, Aston-By-Doxley topped the section with two Holstein Friesians both made £830. Mr A.J. Richardson, Byley sold to £760 and £720. Regular consignors Knaptoft Hall Farm Ltd, Lutterworth sold a run of nineteen today these topped at £720 on two occasions.
