Another good entry today with 178 head changing hands and meeting another fantastic trade.

Messrs P & A Farming, Stoke-On-Trent presented 81 cows randomly selected from their herd. They were a mix of fresh and stale cross bred cows. They topped out at £1,800 for a February calved cow, Lot 1037, sired by Pedro Red and giving 26kg daily. Lot 1048, due in September sold at £1,750 and Lot 1049 again due in September sold for £1,720. The overall average was £1,333.

Youngstock trade continues to gain pace. In calf heifers from MJ & MC Thomasson, Worleston to £1,750, £1,700. Bulling heifers from the same home to £950. With cross breeds to £920, £890, £850 from Messrs HR, SC & OD Bonell, Crewe.

Yearlings, as with previous months looked the dearest cattle on offer, selling to £860 four times from MJ. & MC. Thomasson, Worleston.

Calves, lesser numbers forward but selling to an improved trade £290, £240 four times for crossbred Montbeliardes from Mr I.G. Dodd, Northwich.
