£2,580 TOP - 11 OVER £2,000

Another very good trade with milky young cows again grabbing the high spots.

This week's top price was £2,580 for a second calver from Ray Brown & Partners, Twemlows, with their other second calver achieving the second best cow price of £2,200. MJ & J Rhodes, Goostrey, sold second calvers at £2,150 and £2,000. A fifth calver from MT Jones, Middleton sold for £2,080 and a third calver from Bonsalls Mercaston, Market Drayton made £2,020.

With the best heifers being kept back for next week's Show and Sale, Wyndford Wagyu, Newport, achieved top price in this section at £2,300 with their other heifers making £2,100 and £1,980. DI Ball & Son, Sandbach sold for £2,180, RH Turner, Bradley £2,120, RJ & RH Gadsbey, Yarlet £2,000.

Brown Swiss sold very well with a second calver from Harold Davies & Partners, Puddington at £1,920 and a heifer from OC Whittaker & Sons, Tabley at £1,860.

Only one heifer sold for less than £1,000 which was uneven in the udder at £900.

Heifer calves sold to £300 for British Friesians and Kiwi crossbreds to £65.

Two Aberdeen Angus stock bulls sold for £2,680 (33 months) and £2,420 (35months).
