A good entry forward for the first sale of the New Year. Trade was remarkably good and very consistent. The expectation of the vendors was obviously lower than pre-Christmas, but really there was no need to worry as buyers were present for everything.

Top price of the day was £2,750 from R. Brown & Partners, Twemlows for lot 32 Bidlea Prime Meg off a GP84 mother backed by 8 Generations VG/EX. Others from the same home to £2,600, £2,520, £2,450.

Hankins Heys Farms, Buerton showed five super heifers these peaked at £2,550 and others at £2,460, £2,450 and £2,420. Mr K.J. Morris, Beoley £2,540, T.G. Phillips & Co, Llanymynech £2,440. Of the 35 heifers forward 32 were sold as correct and only two made less than £1,900.

Cows with milk and strength sought after as usual. Top price was £2,420 from A.R. Hough & Partners, Warrington for lot six ARH Linky Red a third calved cow giving 41kgs. Freeford Farms, Litchfield £2,100, D.I. Ball & Son, Sandbach £1,920. Fifth calvers from Mr Rob Taylor, Somerset to £1,700.

A run of six in-calf heifers from Mr R. Davies, Sandhurst due in three to four months' time sold well to £1,520.
