Credit must go to the vendors for a super show of cattle today. Probably one of the best show of heifers we have seen for a long while. Top price today was £2,700 from T.G. Phillips & Co, Llanymynech for Lot 18 Burgedin Rimrock Ella sold giving 34kgs daily, she was very closely followed by Lot 19 Burgedin August Oleo sold giving 34kgs, their other heifer sold at £2,680.

R.F. Goodwin & Son, Earls Croome sold twelve tremendous heifers, this was a super bunch of even heifers with great udders, all selling over £2,000 to a top of £2,610 for Lot 5 a Peak Alta Gulliver daughter giving 36kgs daily. Others from this home £2,580, £2,560, £2,550 —their twelve heifers averaged £2,450. Only four heifers sold for less than £2,000.

Cows a second calved cow from D.&E. Monk, Ormskirk Lot 25 Bannistree Queen 382 G79 sold for £2,450 and another second calved cow from J. Lomax & Son, Baldwins Gate Lot 21 Charlton Pro Helene Red G79 sold for £2,260.
