

## **MILKERS TO 2,050GNS AT ROSS**

Auctioneers Gwilym Richards & Co report a very good trade at Ross-on-Wye Cattle Market from a packed ringside of buyers with fresh milkers selling to 2,050gns.

Richard Skinner of Gloucester sold the top priced calved heifer, Oasis Mr Gold Connie 2<sup>nd</sup>, for 2,050gns to Patrick and Christopher Browning of Berkeley. The same vendor sold another heifer to the same buyers for 1,950gns.

Phillip and Mathew Sevenoaks of Llangorse, Brecon, sold heifers to 2,000gns and 1,920gns.

Cows peaked at 1,750gns for a 4<sup>th</sup> calver from Robert and Stephen Jones of Raglan, Monmouthshire. The same vendor sold two 2<sup>nd</sup> calvers at 1,750gns, and a Brown Swiss 2<sup>nd</sup> calver at 1,750gns.

A 3<sup>rd</sup> calver from Alan Williams of Pontypool sold at 1,700gns.

Dry cows sold to 1,400gns for a Swedish Red cross 3<sup>rd</sup> calver from D & J M Homer, Wiltshire.

February calving heifers sold to 1,220gns from Reading University.

April calving heifers to 1,150gns from T F Harcombe & Son, Worcester and six month old heifer calves from the same home sold to 400gns four times.

A total of 169 cattle were sold to 33 buyers from 12 English and Welsh counties including Devon, Dorset and Denbighshire.
