

ROSS HEIFERS TO 2,220GNS

Auctioneers Gwilym Richards & Co saw prices go through the roof for fresh calved Holstein Friesian heifers at Ross Market with prices peaking at 2,220gns (£2,331.00) and first quality heifers averaging £2,241.75.

The top price was paid for a Woodmarsh Asterisk daughter from Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester, with their consignment of 3 heifers averaging £2,089.50.

Second quality calved heifers sold to 1,700gns and lower quality heifers to 1,000gns.

The supply was totally insufficient for the demand from the large crowd with unsuccessful buyers now looking forward to the next sale.
