Heifers to £2,140 & Cows £2,100

A packed line up of dairy cattle today with nearly fifty milkers presented this combined with the improving weather and Cheshire Show we may have expected an easier trade. Far from it trade was certainly hotter than the weather!

Eleven cattle sold in excess of £1,900 with top price of £2,140 for a quality heifer from Mr A. Mallison, Ramsey his consignment of ten sound heifers averaged £1,735.

This was closely followed by Messrs R.F. & C.A. Tarver, Worcester with their heifers making £2,010 and their consignment averaging £2,000.

Cows were once again highly sort after with top price for a second calver from G.M. Gilman & Partners, Lilleshall at £2,100 and £1,950 from Mr E.L.L. Evans, Denbigh.
