A very large entry with something for everyone.

The best as usual sells well to a top of £2,150 for a heifer from Geoff & Jean Williams, Hay-On-Wye and £2,100 for a second calver from Andy Morris, Redditch.

Two other heifers sold for £2,000 from Mr G. Brown, Pirton and Mr G.J. Sutton, Astbury.

The best trade was for the cows with fifth calvers from Paul Abell, Barthomley selling to £1,800. Second calvers from R. & M. Hopley & Sons, Abbots Bromley sold to £1,910 and £1,900 from E.C. & J. Yarwood & Sons, Medhurst Green.

Heifer calves again met a very good trade with many selling from £245 to £260.

An eighteen month old Simmental stock bull sold for £1,700 and a seventeen month old Angus for £1,050.
