Cows peaked at 1,480gns with Pembrokeshire buyers E M & A D W Davies of Narberth taking home the Crichel Principal sired 2^{nd} calver Vedw Pincipal Buttercup. She had recorded 7,368kgs as a heifer and was giving 40.6kgs when sold 2 months into her 2^{nd} lactation.

Maiden heifers sold to 780gns for the 13 month old Vedw Outside Rose sired by Comestar Outside and out of a 10,431kgs daughter of Joylan Roxcell.

54 of the milking herd recorded prices of over \pounds 1,000 with a further 11 making over \pounds 900.
