ASTOUNDING TRADE - 20 BEST MILKERS - AVERAGE £2,051 HEIFERS TO £2,350 - COWS TO £2,280 - 11 OVER £2,000

What a difference a week makes! After last week's slower trade, today's trade was fast and furious from the word go with the Show and Sale very ably judged by Evan Ellis attracting a better calibre of cattle.

The champion heifer from Liam Phillips of Llanymynech sold for £2,320 and his other two sold for £2,280 and £2,100 to average £2,233. The second prize heifer from Mark Partington, Lancashire sold for £2,300. The top price was £2,350 for a heifer bred by the Winstanley family from Rob Clare.

First time vendors Steve and Will Moore of Middlewich sold their heifers for £2,200 and £2,000. Brownswood Holsteins, Worcester sold to £2,120 and Frank Speed, Crewe £2,020.

The reserve champion and first prize cow from PA & JA Adams, Butterton sold for £2,250. The second prize cow from the Barbour family, Leicestershire sold for £2,280. All were second calvers.

Seven heifers sold in the £1,900s and £1,800s and twelve in the £1,700s and £1,600s with another five milkers over £1,500. There was only one milker less than £1,000.

An Aberdeen Angus stock bull (47 months) sold for £2,400.
