After two weeks of very large entries, there were fewer forward and met a surprisingly easier trade considering the long awaited rain and improved milk prices but producers are struggling with the increased costs.

Malcolm Trevor-Jones, Oswestry topped both sections with heifers to £2,300 and cows to £2,080, his three best cows averaged £2,034.

Steve and Rob Bailey, Lightwood Green sold an Ayrshire heifer for £2,250.

Heifers at £2,000 included Mark Boughey, Iddenshall and Peter and Elizabeth Mercer, Whitchurch.

Dafydd Jones, Corwen sold heifers to £1,950, Rob Gadsbey, Yarlet £1,970, John and Ebs Whittaker, Tabley £1,950.

All 27 milkers averaged £1,784.

In-calf heifers from Peter Lakin, Church Minshull sold to £1,700.

Weanlings sold to £400 and grazing type crossbred calves to £110.

Limousin stock bulls sold at £2,800 (43 months) and £2,200 (33 months).
