HEIFERS £2,800 - COWS £2,720 - BULLS £3,000

Not quite the trade of last week which was expected because of the massive entry and clashing with the Cheshire Ploughing Match. However, another very strong trade with only one animal failing to sell.

AA Winstanley & Partners, Audlem, topped the market for the second week running selling both the top priced heifer at £2,800 and the top priced cow, a second calver at £2,720. Their four second calvers averaged £2,580 and their fifteen heifers £2,391.

GJ Sutton, Astbury sold heifers to £2,450 and cows to £2,400. Mark Wood, Twyford also sold heifers to £2,450 and cows to £2,200.

Rob Gadsbey, Yarlet sold his heifer for £2,400 and Anthony Madders, Adbaston £2,350. Martin Rhodes, Goostrey sold two heifers at £2,250.

Eight cattle in all sold for over £2,500 and thirty seven over £2,000.

Followers met an improving trade with in-calf heifers selling to £1,850, £1,800 twice and £1,700 three times. Bulling heifers to £940 twice and heifer calves to £280.

Simmental stock bulls sold to £3,000 (54 months) and £1,850 (14 months).
