The wet day dampened the trade with all being sold on a very brisk trade but not at the recent high levels.

Both section leaders came from Sophie Round of Gloucester with her cows selling to the day's top price of £2,400 for a third calver and her second calvers selling to £2,380 and £2,300.

Sophie's heifers sold to £2,380 with Wynford Wagyu, Newport selling at £2,250.

The cows were of a better standard compared to the heifers on the whole.

Twelve milkers sold at over £2,000.

Dry cows sold to £1,750.

Norwegian Red cross maidens sold to £580 and Fleckvieh cross to £490.

Heifer calves were again a better trade with British Friesians selling to £165.

Beef stock bulls sold to £1,900 for a Charolais (15 months).
