£3,150 TOP - TOP 10 AVERAGE £2,817 - 16 OVER £2,500 - 32 OVER £2,000

Yet another large entry of fresh milkers selling to another exceptional trade.

Today's top was £3,150 for the pedigree heifer Hankins Sangria Hebe from Hankins Heys Farm, Audlem. She was the first prize pedigree heifer and overall champion of the Monthly Show & Sale supported by the Western Holstein which was sponsored by HJ Lea Oakes and judged by Robert and James Madders.

The second prize pedigree heifer Budworth Apprentice Queen 2 from Hilltop Framing Co, Northwich sold for £2,900 and their other two heifers each sold for £2,850 each, averaging £2,867 for all three.

C Whitticase & Son of St Martins sold heifers at £2,950, £2,550 and £2,500 with their three averaging £2,667.

Other heifers over £2,500 were £2,650 JM Griffin, Sutton Coldfield, £2,650 M & JC Gould, Bomere Heath, £2,620 MW & JM Trevor Jones, Oswestry, £2,620 D & E Monk, Ormskirk, £2,500 Hankins Heys Farm. The first prize commercial heifer sold for £2,720.

The first prize pedigree cow was the second calver Bidlea Grazie Cas from Ray Brown & Partners, Twemlows, she was also the reserve champion and sold for £2,700. Bidlea Bullion Fayne 2 was the second prize pedigree cow and sold for £2,500. All seven second calvers from the Bidlea herd averaged £2,114. The top priced cow at £2,750 was the second calver Jumar Achieve Anita from TM & JM Bowes, Wellenhall.

In all, 32 cattle sold over £2,000 of which 16 were over £2,500.

All 84 milkers averaged £1,904.
