£2,680 TOP PRICE FOR WEEKLY DAIRIES

Today's entry included a mixed bag of cattle with many frail heifers, older cows, cattle with faults and coloured breeds.

However, the best cattle again met keen interest albeit not at the high levels of late indicative of the escalating costs of energy and the availability of fodder stocks.

Calved heifers peaked at £2,680 from S & A May, Bromsgrove, and cows at £2,400 from MJ & J Rhodes, Goostrey.
