£2,400 DAIRY TOP

A totally unexpected brilliant trade after two weeks of easing prices with several new buyers in attendance chasing lower numbers when many more milkers could have been sold to advantage.

Top spot was claimed by John and Ebs Whittaker, Tabley for a calved black and white heifer which sold for £2,400, they also sold another heifer at £2,250 and a Norwegian Red cross heifer for £1,880.

Other heifers sold to £2,320, £2,300 GE Morris, Whitchurch, £2,180, £2,100 D & E Monk, Ormskirk, £2,020 GM & JA Williams, Whitchurch.

Cows were also an excellent trade with a second calver from LF Horton & Sons, Northwich selling for £2,250, a third calver from David Rees Farms, Hunsterson made £2,120, a second calver from D & E Monk sold for £1,950 and a Brown Swiss second calver from Harold Davies & Partners, Puddington also sold for £1,950.

The large entry of dry cows sold particularly well with those due with their third calves from Davenport Farming, Nantwich selling up to £2,200.

Spring calving cross-bred second calvers calving again in May from a mid Wales farm sold to £920.

Stock bulls were also a better trade with Simmentals selling at £2,300 (24 mo.) and £2,100 (19 mo.), Holstein (15 mo.) £1,450 and Hereford (19 mo.) £1,400.
