The top price of £2,500 was for a calved heifer. Heifers over £2,000 included £2,400 Andrew Ball, Sandbach, £2,400 and £2,220 Wyndford Wagyu, Newport, £2,250 and £2,200 Will May, Bromsgrove, £2,200 Hankins Heys Farm, Nantwich, £2,120 David Monk, Ormskirk, £2,100 DH, KS & JS James, Magor.

Cows peaked at £2,300 for a third calver. David Monk sold a second calver for £2,150 and a fourth calver for £2,000.

Dry cows sold to £1,420 and £1,400 and Spring calving cross-breds to £820.

Stock bulls sold to £2,200 for a Simmental (19 months) and Angus bulls at £2,200 (18 months) and £2,100 (19 months).
