HEIFERS TO £2,600 AND COWS TO £2,250

Milk price drops and Stafford Show!! Many thought the trade could be lower this week! How wrong we all were.

Quicker than a sprinter out of the blocks for the first heifer hitting £2,320 from Wyndford Wagyu, Chadwell. Others from the same home to £2,300, £2,250, £2,180.

Next to pass the £2,000 barrier was today's highest priced, a beautiful ABS Grazie sired heifer giving 30kgs daily she sold at £2,600 and another heifer by Claynook Miami sold to £2,580.

LAJ Turner & Son, Wetley Rocks stole the show with their Dujarrier Nobay heifer to £2,300. Other vendors over the £2,000 mark were DE Monk, Ormskirk £2,100, £2,000, Betley Court, Betley £2,060, Kingarth, Leicester £2,020, R Fowler & Sons Ltd, Droitwich £2,000.

A good supply of cows but mostly older cows in today sold to £2,250 from MJ & J Rhodes, Mill Lane and £1,850 from Skinner Bros, Melton Mowbray.

With most youngstock being retained for Monday's youngstock sale we had three in calf heifers which sold to £1,500 from R Fowler & Sons, Droitwich.
