Clashing with Cheshire County Show did not affect today's trade with heifers selling to £2,900 and £2,800 from RG Woolley & Son, Acton.

Nine heifers sold over £2,000 with RJ Clare & Partners, Adderley selling for £2,600, JM Griffin, Sutton Coldfield £2,380 and £2,020, MJ & J Rhodes, Goostrey £2,350 and £2,260, RJ & RH Gadsbey, Yarlet £2,100, ELL Evans, Denbigh £2,000.

All 18 correct Holstein Friesian heifers averaged £2,041 with a three quartered heifer making £1,120.

Today's sale included an array of colours with Ayrshire heifers selling to £1,650, Dairy Shorthorn cross £1,570 twice and Jersey cross to £850 three times.

There were no first quality cows forward with the best selling to £1,680.

In-calf heifers sold to £1,500 and heifer calves to £360.

A 31 month old pure bred Limousin stock bull made £3,620.

Next week's sale includes a number of consignments of fresh heifers with 8 from one East Anglian farm.
