Bulling heifers sold to 950gns and heifer calves to 620gns.

The 12,000 litre Mueller bulk tank sold for £12,000, 500 tons of Maize Silage made £11,500, the Zero Grazing Forager reached £5,000 and the two Bunkers £2,600 each.
