£2,380 TOP FOR BOTH COWS AND HEIFERS

A decent sized entry to start 2024 with something for everyone.

Heavy milking cows again topped the trade with a second calver from LF Horton & Sons, Northwich at $\pm 2,380$ and another second calver at $\pm 2,100$. Third calvers sold to $\pm 2,250$ and fourth calvers to $\pm 2,220$ from EA & NJ Griffiths & Son, Leominster.

Heifers from Marcus Callwood, Knutsford also matched the £2,380 top price with RW & EE Edwards & Sons, Whitchurch selling to £2,100 and £1,980.

The mixed quality entry included longer calved cattle because of the Christmas and New Year break with other heifers making up to £1,800 and cows to £1,850 and £1,820.

Dry cows sold to £1,320. Cross bred heifers calving in late Spring sold to £470, maidens to £420 and yearlings to £330.
