A very mixed entry today with a high percentage of faulted cattle. With show and sale next week, a few real top enders were retained for next week. Trade was very good on stronger, milky cattle, both cows and heifers and extremely good on faulted and older cattle.

Leading the day with a second calved cow at £2,320 was MW. & TM. Trevor-Jones, The Elms she was sweet but compact cow yielding 38kgs. Cross bred cows from H. Davies & Partners, Puddington sold to £1,980 for their third calved cow.

Heifer trade was very consistent peaking at £2,250 for an aristocrat daughter from DH. &KS. James, Caldicot. Also at the same money was a Marvel daughter from D. & SC. Sutton, Crewe and their Vader daughter selling to £2,150. Other vendors over £2,000, D.I. Ball & Son, Smallwood £2,080 twice. Mr R.N. Thompson, Sudbury £2,080 and RA. & JE. Williams, Hay-On-Wye £2,080.

Aged and Cross bred dry cows sold to £1,200 from Mr J. Berrisford, Crewe.

Served heifers reached a much improved trade, selling to £1,100 from Severnmeadow Farms, Sandhurst.

Weaned calves £310 from NT. & M. Dale & Sons, Much Wenlock.

Calves on milk to £180 from PRF. & EA. Stone, Stafford.
