A smaller entry sold to a much improved trade. A very mixed entry but all sold very easily this week.

The heifer section was led by D.&E. Monk, Ormskirk, their heifers selling to £2,450 and £2,400 both heifers were backed with 6 generations VG/EX and 4 generation of VG/EX and both pumping out 35kgs of milk.

Another super heifer giving 34kgs was a commercial heifer at £2,350 from MW. & JW. Trevor-Jones, The Elms.

Heifers which had been selling around the £1,500 mark in the last two weeks rocketed to a higher level with most making £1,800 plus.

Ayrshire heifers to £1,880 and Brown Swiss to £1,880.

Cows again easily sold especially if they looked like milk. Topping the section was a third calved cow from M. & S. Wilson, Crewe she was bred in the Rowarton Herd and was sold giving 40kgs plus.

Friesian maidens to £550 from Mr BAT. Kirkham, Mayfield.

Calves very dear and well sold again this week selling to £300 and £280 from D. & E. Monk, Ormskirk.

Two 7 to 10 months old Pedigree Limousin bulls sold to £1,580 and £1,200 from Mr G.J. Smith, Myddle.
