In-calf heifers sold to 1,150gns for the January 2004 born Moet Lookout daughter, Janmac Look Fran 2nd. She was due in October to an Aberdeen Angus service, and her Joylan USA dam's best lactation was 8,825kgs. The purchasers were R H & S M Mason, Hereford.

Messrs Mason also purchased her January 2005 born full sister which led the maiden heifer prices for 800gns.
