TOP PRICE COW £3,150 TOP PRICE HEIFER £3,500

Another good entry in the dairy section today with sixty-nine passing through the ring. Again, a tale of two halves with the best a very strong trade but second quality more difficult to place with milk prices sliding.

Leading the way was lot 3 from RJ. & RH. Gadsbey, Yarlet for their Denovo Kenmore heifer she was top price at £3,500 and another heifer lot 2 from the Gadsbeys and again by Denovo Kenmore reached £3,120.

Messrs GH. & AH. James, Caldicot sold a super run of seven fresh heifers, all pedigree selling to £3,300, £3,080, £3,020 x 2, £2,850 x 2 and £2,820. Mr R.A. Bown, Hanley Castle £2,950 and £2,600. Tomkinson Farms, Gnosall £2,780. D. & E. Monk, Ormskirk £2,750.

Cows £3,400 from L.F. Horton & Sons, Northwich for lot 35 Heathleigh Alcove Flora, GH. &AH. James, Caldicot £3,150, Lees Dairy Farms, Adderley £3,000, D.& E. Monk, Ormskirk £2,700 and RJ. & RH. Gadsbey, Yarlet £2,620.

Second quality cows and heifers were harder to sell and were generally £1,200 to £1,800, these were mostly Crossbred Dairies or British Friesian types yielding 18 to 24kgs.

Yearling heifers from Mr T.S. Sellers, Powys to £940 to average £728 for nine sold.
